There is a severe shortage of affordable housing. Too many projects are slowing down, construction of new houses is too expensive, and investors have too much influence. D66 wants to tackle this by building specifically for first-time buyers and the middle segment and by preventing houses from being bought to rent. We want to develop a lively Campus on Zernike with housing and facilities for students and young people.



Climate leadership in a green municipality

We have planted thousands of trees and renewable energy generation is increasing rapidly. D66 wants to further accelerate the transition to more sustainability with even more sustainable generation. We do this by using residual heat and by helping residents installing solar panels on their roofs. In addition, we aim for a reduction in emissions: by giving priority to bicycles, public transport, a train to Zernike and the Lelylijn.
